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BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE ISOPE BYLAWS AND ACTIVITIES

The Society was established in September 15, 1989 and shall be operated as a nonprofit organization (exempt organization under the U.S. IRS Code section 501(c)(3)) exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes.

The primary purposes of the Society shall be (i) to advance at an international level the arts and sciences in and promote and improve technological progress in the interdisciplinary fields of offshore, ocean and polar engineering and related technologies through international cooperation and participation; (ii) to disseminate scientific knowledge and provide timely exchange of technical knowledge and information; and (iii) to provide opportunities through its programs for interested individuals to maintain and improve their individual technical competence in these fields, for the benefit of the public and the interested engineers in these fields.

The Board of Directors shall maintain international balance and represent diversity in technical interests and activities. The Board shall determine the status of all committees appointed - standing or ad hoc. The activities, property, and affairs of the Society shall be managed by the Board of Directors; the Board may exercise all such powers of the Society and shall not be prohibited except by applicable statutes, the Society's Articles of Incorporation, or these Bylaws.

ISOPE members direct one of the largest technical conferences in the interdisciplinary fields of offshore, ocean, polar, marine, environment, energy, resources, materials and related applied research and engineering. Society membership encompasses a variety of activities including technical conferences, publications, scholarship and professional recognition programs, continuing education, and international cooperation.

ISOPE MEMBER BENEFITS

Notes on Membership Benefits. All fee-paid members receive all conference and symposium programs and newsletters, and lower member rates for the conference registration fees and the publications. All fee-paid members will receive complimentary IJOPE copies regardless of member grade. Membership runs on a Calendar Year basis (January - December). Renewals are due by January 31 annually.

MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

The membership of the Society shall not be limited by nationality, race, color, creed, or sex, but shall be limited to those individuals and organizations who fulfill membership requirements including the payment of dues and fees, and whose paper was ever accepted for one of the ISOPE meetings or Journal, or who receive endorsement of qualifications from one of the ISOPE members for membership.

Fellow: Fellow grade is promoted from Member status.

Member

The applicant must hold a college degree, equivalent to a four-year B.S. degree, in any of the branches of engineering or basic or applied sciences, and must have at least six years' active practice after a college degree in the application of the sciences to any branch of offshore, ocean, polar, materials or related applied engineering. Three years of this experience must be in a position of responsibility. Master's degree or equivalent equals one year of employment, and doctoral degree equals two years of employment. **Dues: US\$130. Retirees: US\$70 per year.**

Associate Member

The applicant must hold a college degree equivalent to a four-year B.S. degree in any of the branches of engineering or basic or applied sciences, and must be or has been engaged in work related to offshore, ocean, polar, materials or related applied engineering. Master's degree or equivalent equals one year of employment, and doctoral degree equals two years of employment. **Dues: US\$130. Retirees: US\$70 per year.**

Student Member

The applicant must be a full-time student in good standing at a college or equivalent institute approved by the Board of Directors of the Society. The person must be endorsed by an instructor, preferably an ISOPE member. Student members have voting rights only after promotion to the grade of Associate Member. **Dues: US\$70 per year.**

Submission of Manuscripts to the Journals: International Journal of Offshore and Polar Engineering, and Journal of Ocean and Wind Energy. Authors are invited to submit (e-mail attach) a WORD or PDF file of the manuscript directly to Technical Editor (editor@isope.org). The manuscript must be accompanied by a statement that it has not been published elsewhere (except at ISOPE meetings) nor submitted for publication elsewhere.
